- Developed an automated data request system for NSHD, a cohort study involving people born in England, Scotland, and Wales who have participated in extensive physical, cognitive, and mental health assessments. This automation replaced the previous manual email-based process, creating a seamless and efficient experience for the data management team to handle daily data requests.
  - Leveraged Microsoft Power Automate and TypeScript to develop an automated data request system for NSHD.
  - Continuously monitored and debugged the system to resolve any arising issues.
- Managed the research data for SABRE, a cohort study managed by the MRC LHA (Medical Research Council Unit for Lifelong Health and Ageing) comparing cardiovascular disease and diabetes between different ethnic groups.
  - Created an ETL system that ingests NHS-linked data for SABRE into an SQL database and extracts this data for future use.
  - Built an ETL system to transform and streamline SABRE data for research use, ensuring adherence to the principle of least privilege.
  - Managed incoming data requests for SABRE on a day-to-day basis.
- Facilitated the transition of the NSHD data showcase to align with the UK Biobank Data Showcase.
  - Automated the encoding of NSHD variables, ensuring metadata consistency.
  - Migrated variable information into the database to support the data showcase.
